## Nearly 90% of US counties have no abortion provider.

An estimated one million children, mostly girls, enter the sex trade each year.

In Bangkok & Bangladore & Meldova, literally millions of young women are either kidnapped, sold by their starving families, or lured with the promise of employment---then sold across borders into a sex slave trade on a scale never seen before in history.....

Pornography has become increasingly violent, cruel, and degrading towards women: women are referred to as "cumdumpsters" and "fuckbuckets."

In 2011-2013, more restrictions on abortion have been enacted than in the ENTIRE PREVIOUS DECADE.

In the Congo, where the rape of women has been a systematic part of civil war. Tens of thousands of women and young girls have been so brutally raped that their insides are torn apart and they can no longer hold their bladders or bowels.

One out of four female college students will be raped or sexually assaulted while in college.

One out of three women who join the U.S. Military will be sexually assaulted or raped by men in the U.S. Military.

Veteran porn actor & producer Bill Marigold: "I'd like to really show what I believe the men want to see: violence against women...The most violent we can get is the cum shot in the face. Men can get off behind that because they get even with the women they can't have."

The United States imprisons onethird of all women in the world who are in prison.

Suicide is the most common cause of death for girls and women 15- to 19-years old worldwide.

Studies show that porn gives permission to its consumers to treat women as they are treated in porn. In El Salvador, women are arrested out of hospital emergency rooms if they are suspected of having an abortion: their medical records have been seized by the state, & even their uteruses have been used as evidence to imprison them.

A 2010 survey by Psychologies magazine in the U.K. found that a third of 14- to 16-year olds had first seen sexual images online when they were 10 or younger. 81% of those polled looked at porn online at home, while 61% could access it online at home.

At least 38 states have introduced fetal homicide laws that were intended to be used against violent attacks by third parties like abusive male partners. But in South Carolina, only one case has been brought against a man for assaulting a pregnant woman, while up to 300 women have been arrested under the law, according to the National Advocates for Pregnant Women.
